

CT CHEST (PLAIN + CONTRAST)

Technique: Plain & contrast-enhanced CT scan of the Chest was performed.

REPORT:

Bilateral lungs appear normal. No ground-glass opacities or consolidations or sinister focal lesion.

No focal enhancing lesion in both lungs.

Thymus appears normal. No focal lesion seen.

Trachea and major airways appear patent.

No evidence of pleural or pericardial effusion.

No significant mediastinal or hilar lymphadenopathy.

Mediastinal vasculature appears normal.

MPA – 19.0mm, RPA ms. 11.0mm, LPA ms. 10.0mm in diameter.

Cardiac chambers are normal in size.

Visualized thoracic esophagus appears normal.

Visualized bones appear normal for age.

IMPRESSION:- Plain and contrast-enhanced CT chest reveals no significant abnormality.
